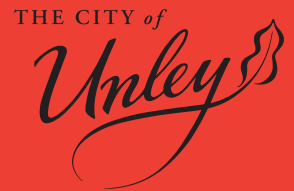

Family History

The Unley Library Service provides a variety of resources for the family historian at the Unley Civic Centre Library.

Family History

The Unley Library Service Family History Collection provides access to a range of resources which you can utilise in performing your family history research. These resources include birth, death and marriage certificates for the Adelaide district on microfiche and much more.

Access to the collection is through the Family History volunteers, who can often offer helpful pointers to assist you in your own research. They are not researchers and are consequently not able to perform your research for you.

Opening Hours

The Family History collection is accessible:

- > Tuesday: 10:00am to 4:00pm
- > Thursday: 1:00pm to 6:30pm

Family History is located in The Attic on the first floor of the Unley Civic Library.

Access for overseas, interstate and country SA

If you live interstate or in country South Australia and are unable to visit the Unley Family History collection, our volunteers may be able to provide assistance for birth, death and marriage certificate searches. To request this service contact the Family History volunteers during opening hours on 8372 5426. If they can assist you with their request you will be sent A Family History Request Form in the post, which you must complete and return with a stamped self-addressed envelope. Estimated turnaround time for search requests is 28 days (this is dependent on available resources and the number of requests received). No more than three requests per person can be made at any one time.

Births, Deaths and Marriages - Adelaide District Register

Copies of birth, death and marriage certificates for the Adelaide district are available on microfiche in the following date ranges:

- > Births: 1856 to 1922 (index with useful information to 1928)
- > Deaths: 1864 to 1967 (index to 1972)
- > Marriages: 1868 to 1937

Records are available for the Adelaide district only. Due to their age some certificates may have poor legibility.

Please note that photocopies or prints of the certificates cannot be made.

Resources on CD-ROM

Victorian birth, death and marriage indexes from 1836 - 1920 are available on CD-ROM along with South Australian pre-civil registration births, deaths and marriages and a range of other electronic resources. These resources are available for use during Family History opening hours only.
